



September Revenues Outpace the Estimate

General Fund revenue collections for the month ended September 2013 totaled \$2.43 billion, which was \$15.2 million, or 0.6%, above estimate for the month. Fiscal year-to-date collections total \$6.1 billion, which is \$12.8 million, or 0.2%, above estimate for the year. Total General Fund revenues through September 2013 are \$40.7 million, or 0.7%, ahead of revenues last year at this time. September is a "quarterly estimated tax payment" month for calendar year corporate and individual filers.

September's overall corporation tax collections were below estimate by \$8.2 million for the month. Capital stock and franchise tax collections were \$19.7 million, or 44%, above estimate for the month. Annual corporate net income tax payments were \$27.6 million above estimate for the month; however, quarterly estimated CNI tax payments were \$55.4 million below estimate for the month. This is noteworthy because December is the final quarterly estimated tax payment month for 2013 CNI tax payments, and so the relatively weak performance for September may be repeated in a few months when quarterly

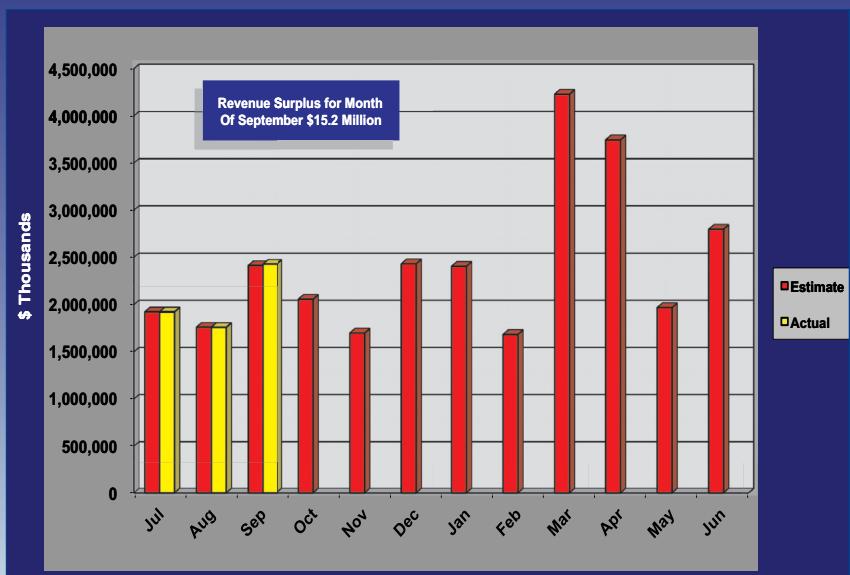
estimated payments are due once again.

Personal income tax collections were above estimate by \$8.3 million for the month. Employers' withholding was \$10.2 million below estimate for the month, and non-withholding payments were over estimate by \$18.5 million. Employers' withholding collections were 1.5% ahead of September 2012, which is an indication that income and employment gains remain modest, at best. Individual

quarterly estimated tax payments for September were 9.8% above last year, which may reflect stronger gains from non-job related income such as the stock market. Total year-to-date PIT collections through September 2013 are \$80 million, or 3.3%, more than last year at this time. The FY 2013-14 Official General Fund Revenue Estimate calls for annual PIT growth of 3.13% over last year.

Sales and use tax collections were just under estimate for the month by \$880,864. Non-motor SUT was below estimate by \$2.4 million for the month, but SUT on motor vehicles was above estimate by \$1.5 million. SUT collections through September 2013 are 2.9% ahead of last fiscal year. The FY 2013-14 Official General Fund Revenue Estimate calls for annual SUT growth of 3.77% over last year.

Realty transfer tax was above estimate by \$6.3 million, or 21.8%, for the month. A recent jump in mortgage rates does not appear to have caused a sharp drop in the real estate market, and still-recovering prices should continue to bolster the housing sector going forward. Inheritance tax collections were \$3 million above estimate for the month. Cigarette tax collections just missed the estimate by

\$263,888, and liquor tax collections and table games tax collections were \$1.8 million and \$419,166 below estimate for the month, respectively. Non-tax revenue collections exceeded the estimate by \$9.2 million.

Motor License Fund collections were \$4.9 million below estimate for the month of September. The Motor License Fund is \$16.4 million below estimate for the year.

State Departments and Agencies to Submit Budget Requests

Recently, Governor Corbett issued his budget program and policy guidelines to the departments and agencies whose budget he controls. The program policy guidelines provide direction for the preparation of the Governor's FY 2014-15 Executive Budget agency budget requests.

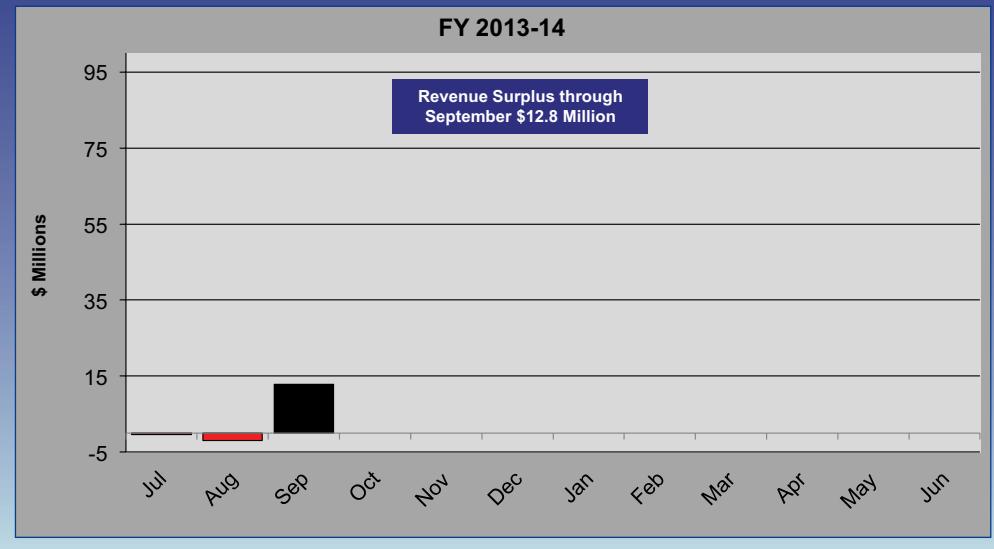
Departments and agencies are required to submit their proposed budget requests to the Governor's office. According to the Governor, departments and agencies should not assume funding increases for the 2014-15 fiscal year and should continue to evaluate current programs and recommend changes that will im-

prove program management and operations, reduce costs and optimize direct services.

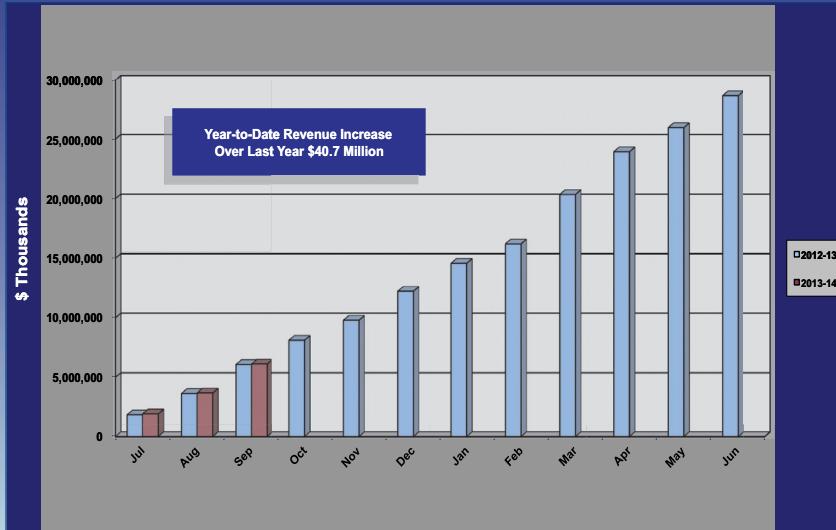

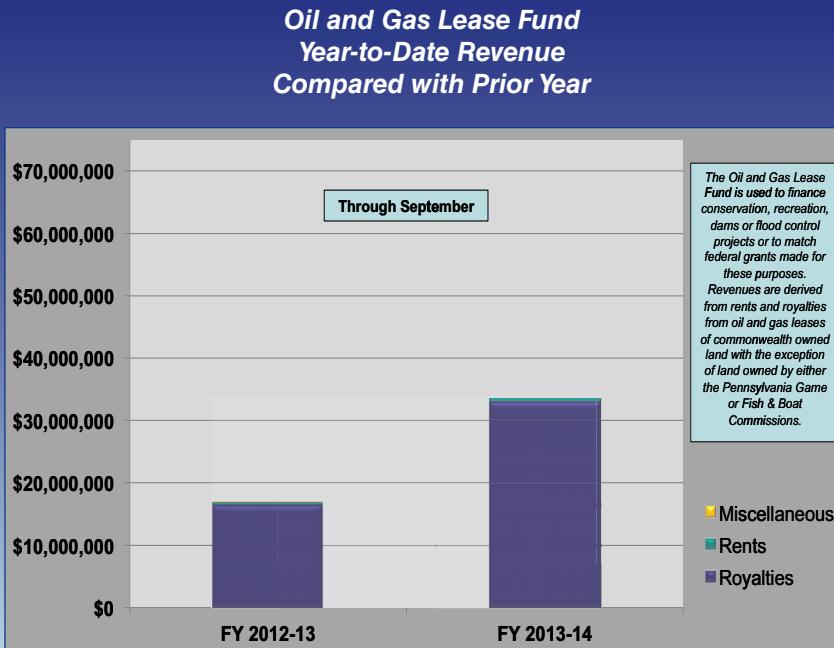


**General Fund Tax Collections

with Official Estimate**



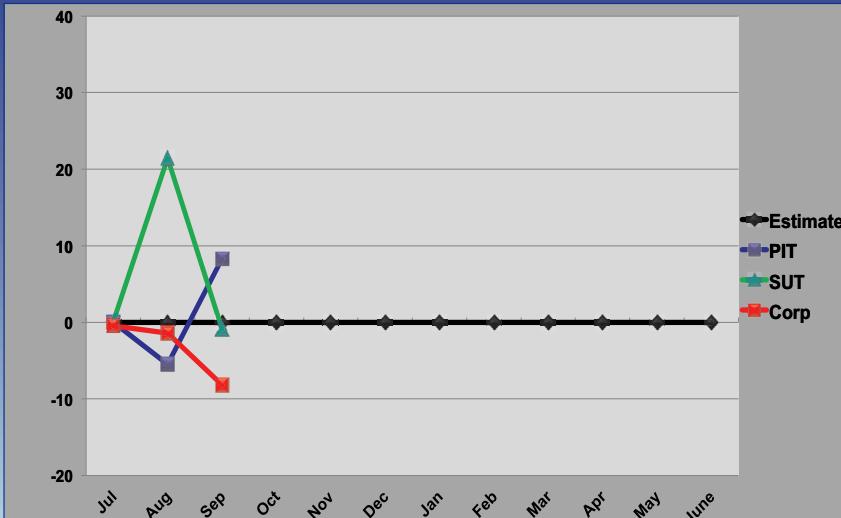
**General Fund Revenue Collections
